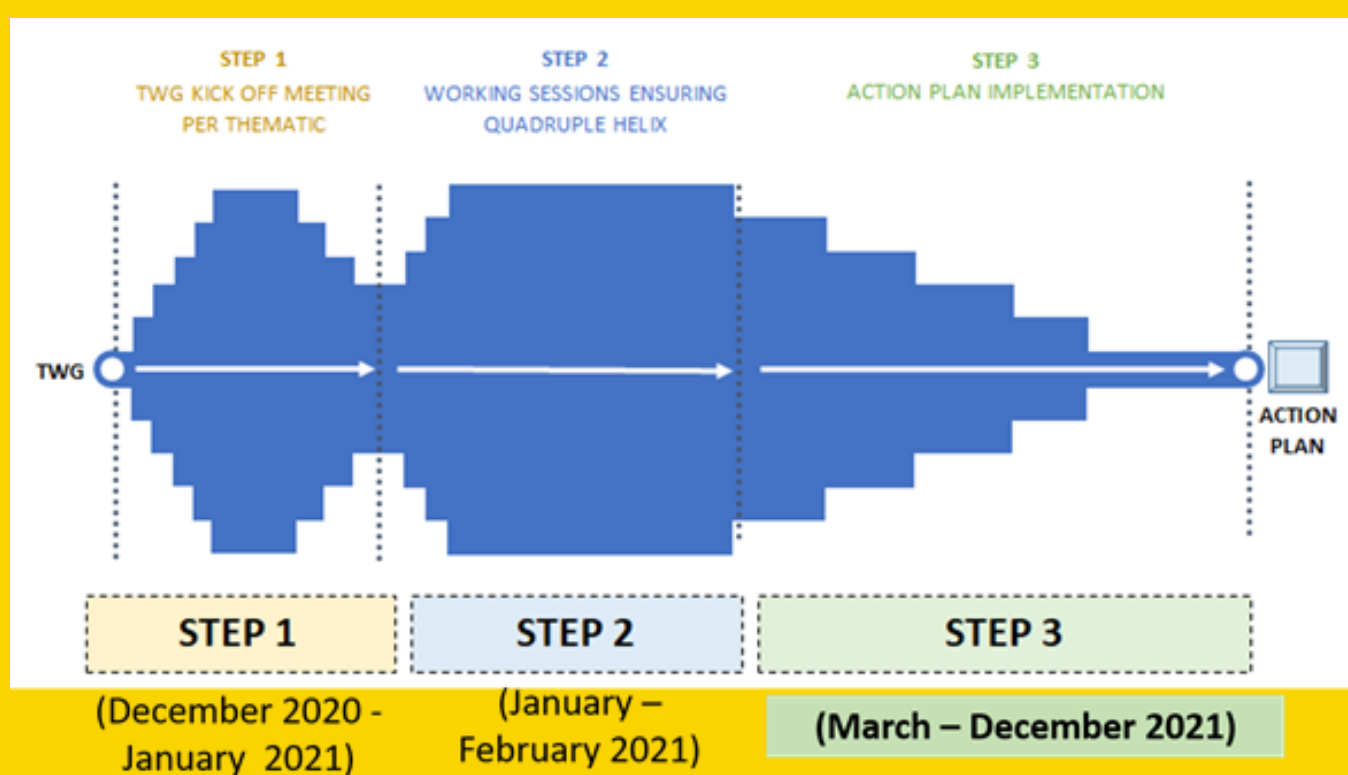
5 OBJECTIVES OF TWG ALIGNED WITH HIGH POTENTIAL OF ORS :

- 1 Improve ORs' excellence in research and innovation with an action plan
- 2 Raise their participation in European research and innovation projects
- 3 Link research activities with territorial development
- 4 Submit at least one or two proposals within Horizon Europe calls for projects
- 5 Establish actions for long-term cooperation



THEMATIC ACTION PLAN : CO-CREATION AND IMPLEMENTATION

Exchanges between the ORs experts began with the Kick-off Meeting of each thematic working group.



THREE MISSIONS HAVE BEEN CARRIED OUT WITHIN THESE MEETINGS

- 1 The co-creation of the thematic actions
- 2 Working sessions ensuring the presence of stakeholders from quadruple helix (public organizations, researchers, universities, civil society)
- 3 The implementation of the action plan. The thematic working group of the ORs should continue after the end of the FORWARD project

Around 593 members since the beginning of the work of the thematic groups.

The composition of the thematic working groups is heterogeneous. It is, indeed, the first time all outermost regions are gathered to discuss issues and projects in the perspective of Horizon Europe.
